

# Unrestricted access routes to the Clandeboye Lodge over the Christmas period

The **Ballysalagh Road** has been closed due to repairs caused by accidental damage to the Estate Bridge, which sits on the Bangor side of our location.

However, access to the Clandeboye Lodge is open to traffic **from Newtownards** using the **Crawfordsburn Road** and from the **Craigantlet Hills** by following the **Craigantlet Road**.

On both these routes you should ignore the Road Closure/ Diversion signs, as access is open to the Clandeboye Lodge from these roads.

Traffic approaching the Clandeboye Lodge from **Bangor** or **Belfast**, using the main **Bangor to Belfast A2 dual carriageway**, should turn off at either **Ballymoney Road** or **Whinney Hill**, both of which join the **Craigantlet Road** at the staggered crossroads (beside the Crossroads Church).

Again, you can drive through any diversion signs at the crossroads as access is open through to the Clandeboye Lodge from this point.

By selecting the option best suited to your starting location, it should only take a few minutes extra to get to/from the Clandeboye Lodge.

We are sorry for any inconvenience and are working with the powers that be to get the bridge and the road re-instated as soon as possible.
